Our history: HolidayFest, a 100% volunteer-run organization, has been part of Hendersonville and the cities and unincorporated areas of Sumner County since 2007. Through events and partnerships, we have contributed nearly \$4,000,000.00 to area charities.

December: Breakfast with Santa (12/7)

Prominent community members, sponsors, the King and Queen of HolidayFest, and many dignitaries attend this event that includes a VIP party, seated dinner, silent and live auction and dancing with live entertainment. This event benefits Shalom Zone.

The parade is one of the signature events of HolidayFest. The Parade today has over 90 entries which include bands, horses, and antique cars.
