Our history: HolidayFest, a 100% volunteer-run organization, has been part of Hendersonville and the cities and unincorporated areas of Sumner County since 2007. Through events and partnerships, we have contributed nearly \$4,000,000.00 to area charities.

Why HolidayFest needs sponsors: HolidayFest is a non-profit organization that exists to help other non-profits organizations in Sumner County and surrounding areas. Sponsorship allows us to provide financial and experienced guidance to selected charities in the promotion of their organization through events at the concept and execution stage of the event. HolidayFest, to list just a few logistical and management actions we take – enters contracts, reserves space, pays catering, arranges logistical, audio visual, printing, and provides event insurance requirements, and more. After conclusion of an event, proceeds are donated to the selected charity.

September - Champions of Valor

This event benefits CASA. Champions of Valor is an annual HolidayFest season kick off celebration. It is a fun-filled, heartwarming breakfast with Awards. This event is always a celebration of those who make dreams come true and is unique and exciting every year.

Expected attendance: 150 people.

September - Food & Wine Festival



Dinner, an event that showcases a curated collection of five chefs, each presenting their signature course, elevated wine pairings and entertainment. Saturday is The Grand Tasting, a showcase of artisan food and beverages, with a Maker's Market – an area that presents award winning authors and artisans from middle Tennessee. Expected attendance: For the dinner, 100 prominent area citizens.

October - Gentlemen's Committee

Gentlemen's Committee Poker and Celebrate Tennessee. This annual event brings together community members for an evening of fun and fundraising in support of the selected charities. Eddie Robertson, Jeffery Sasse, and Bryson McCarley are the chairs.







October: Football for the Cure

Football for the Cure, this is a new HolidayFest event, and is expected to become a tradition. Raising funds for cancer awareness and research, Football for the Cure will bring together people of all ages and income levels. Founded by Jameson Wharton at age 10, when he lost his grandmother to cancer. Last year's proceeds benefited the American Cancer Society and Vanderbilt Ingram Cancer Center.



October: Pig Fest Hendersonville

PIGFEST. This year's PIGFEST benefits Mary's Magical Place, Christmas 4 Kids and Live.Love.Nashville. The two-day event features local musical talent, shows, cook-off's, car shows and more.

Thousands attend this event over the two days.



November: Sparkle Noel

Sparkle Noel. Beauty, fashion, and fun are all here at this annual event. This year's event benefits Parker Strong Foundation, a resource for suicide prevention and education. This event is one of the most anticipated Sumner County, and the 250 seats are always sold out to an exceptional crowd of men and women who are prominent in Sumner County. Each year the event garners significant press coverage including Star News, Hendersonville Standard, Gallatin Examiner, Your Sumner Magazine, and others.







November: Christmas Tree Elegance

Christmas Tree Elegance benefits Monthaven Arts and Cultural Center. This annual event brings people from the community, dignitaries, artists, and government officials who enjoy and support the many fantastic programs Monthaven conducts each year. Donated decorated trees are auctioned at the event.

Expected attendance: 150 people.



November: Indian Lake Loop

Indian Lake Loop. Benefits COMPASS. The Indian Lake LOOP has become a Thanksgiving tradition for Sumner County. This 5K Walk and Run benefits COMPASS. Every year over 1500 people gather at the Streets of Indian Lake and start the morning off at 8am. By the time the event is over, the Turkey is ready and all are off to a wonderful Thanksgiving. This has been one of the major fundraisers for COMPASS and it has grown every year. An event the entire family can enjoy.



November: Breakfast with Santa

Santa Breakfast, Benefiting Community Childcare Services Inc. This annual event has two seatings and is full in both fun and capacity, serving over 450 people. Photos with Santa, goodie bags, treats, and more as each event ticket includes a full breakfast with beverage. Children of all ages enjoy the event, as do the parents and grandparents who attend.







December: Christmas Boat Parade

Hendersonville Boat Parade, benefits the Literacy Council of Hendersonville. This annual event is fun for the whole family. Thousands of people gather to watch the parade each year.



December: Festival of Lights

Ultimate Party Festival of Lights. This family-fun event attracts thousands as the city of Hendersonville shows off the best of the best in residential and commercial property holiday lights!



December: Christmas Parade

The parade is one of the signature events of HolidayFest. The Parade today has over 90 entries which include bands, horses, and antique cars. Every year we have a GRAND MARSHALL, the King and Queen of HolidayFest along with their court of Lords and Ladies. Judges are celebrities and local businesspeople, including Scott Couch and Holly Thompson.

December- Christmas Tree Lighting

This annual event includes musical entertainment, food, carriage rides, and the lighting of the Christmas Tree by the Hendersonville Mayor. Thousands of people attend this fun, family event.



December- St. Nicolas Ball

This annual HolidayFest social event of the season for Sumner County will be held at the Premiere Center, Hendersonville. Prominent community members, sponsors, the King and Queen of HolidayFest, and many dignitaries attend this event that includes a VIP party, seated dinner, silent and live auction and dancing with live entertainment. Attendees are upper-income community-members. This event benefits CaSA.

Expected attendance: 250 people (sold out in 2023)

The Appalachian Christmas Dinner has become a holiday tradition for Sumner County and storytellers across the country. Last year, it was a catered dinner held at historic Stonewall Mansion, with a live storyteller, live music, and fun the whole family can enjoy. The Appalachian Christmas Dinner benefits Special Needs Sports Foundation and Project 22. Each dinner is limited to 40 people.

Expected attendance: 40 people/dinner (3 nights)
